


# McArthur Island Park Facility Map



## About the Park

Located on the north bank of the Thompson River, McArthur Island Park is a must visit for the active tourist. Golf, soccer, football, baseball, and cricket games can be viewed as you stroll around the perimeter of the park on the paved trail. McArthur Island is the home to many of Kamloops sports and recreation facilities. The 51 ha. (126 ac.) island is lavishly equipped with a variety of playing fields, a golf course, indoor sports centre, bicycle paths, parks and picnic land, lagoon, wild flora and fauna reserve, BMX track, walking trails and so much more.

## How to get there:

- From West: Take Exit 369 to Columbia St/City Centre, Left on Summit Dr, Right on Victoria St W, Take North Shore Ramp, Exit Right to Tranquille Rd, Left on Yew, Right on MacKenzie to park entrance
- From East: Exit Right to City Centre, Stay Right on Battle St, Stay Right on Lansdowne St, Stay Left to North Shore/Tranquille/Airport Ramp, Exit Right to Tranquille Rd, Left on Yew St, Right on MacKenzie to park entrance
- From South: Merge Right onto Hwy 1/5/97, follow Hwy 1/5/97 directions from West
- From North: Right at North Thompson River Connector/Halston Ave, Left on 12th St, continue straight to park entrance
