The Edmonton International Track Classic will be held on July 5-6, 2014 with the invitational section to be held on the afternoon of Sunday July 6. It will be the third meeting of the National Track League (NTL) Series and first major international meeting in North America after the Caribbean, Canadian and United States National Championships.

Pace Maker


There will be pace makers focusing on milestone times.

Local Transport


