

PRI Newsletter #37 – Fall Programs and Upcoming Events

1. Pickleball Regina Fall Programs

The Program committee has arranged several options for indoor play this Fall and Winter. The Fall term will run for the months of October, November and December and the Winter term for the months of January through mid-April.

Host(s) are required for all sessions. Members who volunteer to host will be guaranteed a spot. Training and assistance will be provided. Please contact Les Kingston (<u>leskin@sasktel.net</u>) if you are willing to take on this responsibility. Failure to find volunteer hosts will result in cancellation of the session and/or reassignment of the time slot.

Programs are priced to recover the rent charged (from \$55 - \$75/hour), to make a contribution to the Dedicated Courts fund and to cover the cost of equipment and supplies. All program hosts and Board members are unpaid volunteers and participants are expected to assist with set-up and take-down of equipment.

A Sign Up Genius invitation will be issued in August for the Fall term. Due to the limited number of spots available, you may register for a maximum of two separate sessions in a term. E.g. you may sign up for the Monday evening Open Play and a Saturday Shootout. Also, the people who have volunteered with Pickleball Regina programs in 2019 will be given first chance to sign up. Three days after registration has been offered to the volunteer group, registration will be opened to all Pickleball Regina members for the remaining spots

Payment instructions will be included with the Sign Up Genius invitation and payment will be required via debit or credit card to secure your spot(s).

Note - Participation in 3.0+ and 3.5+ Rated sessions will be restricted to individuals with Club or Tournament skill ratings at the relevant level. We are arranging for Brooke Siver to conduct more skill rating sessions. Dates to be confirmed.

Dates are yet to be determined at the Regina Christian School and at Evraz, but the programs and dates have been confirmed at Ecole Monseigneur de Laval, 1601 Cowan Crescent (at Hillsdale).
