
# 3. Way to Go!! Skills and Training Volunteers Excel:

# 4. Pickleball Regina Fall Programs

The Program committee has arranged several options for indoor play this Fall and Winter. The Fall term will run for the months of October, November and December and the Winter term for the months of January through mid-April.

We have booked dates at Ecole Monseigneur de Laval, 1601 Cowan Crescent (at Hillsdale) and the Canada Centre East building (Evraz Place). However, the COV-ID-19 pandemic situation means that things could change unexpectedly – especially with regard to the Laval school gym rental. So, this schedule reflects our current plan for the Fall term, and we will hold off opening registration until the second week of September in case adjustments are required.

The Regina Christian School board has not decided whether or not to rent to outside parties, so it is not included in the proposed schedule at this time.

Host(s) are required for all sessions. Members who volunteer to host will be guaranteed a spot. Training and assistance will be provided. Please contact Les Kingston (<a href="leskin@sasktel.net">leskin@sasktel.net</a>) if you are willing to take on this responsibility. Failure to find volunteer hosts will result in cancellation of the session and/or reassignment of the time slot.

Programs are priced to recover the rent charged (from \$55 - \$75/hour), to make a contribution to the Dedicated Courts fund and to cover the cost of equipment and supplies. All program hosts and Board members are unpaid volunteers and participants are expected to assist with set-up and take-down of equipment.

A Sign Up Genius invitation will be issued in September for the Fall term. Due to the limited number of spots available, you will be able to register for a maximum of one session initially. Also, the people who have volunteered with Pickleball Regina programs in 2019 and 2020 will be given first chance to sign up. Three days after registration has been offered to the volunteer group, registration will be open to all Pickleball Regina members.

Waitlists will be available for every session. By signing up on a waitlist, the program committee will know if there is enough interest to offer another similar session.

Payment instructions will be included with the Sign Up Genius invitation and payment will be required via debit or credit card to secure your spot(s).

**Note** - Participation in 3.0+ and 3.5+ Rated sessions will be restricted to individuals with Club or Tournament skill ratings at the relevant level. We are planning to hold a ratings clinic before registration opens in September. Dates, times and locations to be confirmed.

# **5.** Renew Your Membership:

A large number of memberships are due for renewal each August. You should have received a reminder from Pickleball Canada to renew your membership. Keeping your membership up to date keeps your Sport Accident insurance in force plus provides opportunity to receive invitations to register for organized play and training opportunities.
