### 1. City of Regina Opens Pickleball Courts

Effective June 3, 2020, courts operated by the City of Regina have re-opened under the rules for Individual Outdoor Recreation. This allows for singles play; or doubles with partners from the same household.

Members are reminded that participation is limited to 10 players and will expand to 30 players effective June 8, as part of the Phase 3 re-opening. Organized PRI play is still part of Phase 4; no date has been provided for its activation.

Remember to bring your own hand sanitizer as the City will not be providing it. Bathrooms are not available at Douglas Park and the Mahon Courts remain under construction until later this summer. PRI continues prepare
