



Red Deer Pickleball Club Player Ratings Policy

August 18, 2022

1. Ratings are based on gender doubles play, not mixed
2. If a player self rates in pickleballbrackets.com and that player has a utpr from the US, the UTPR rating will be used.
3. If a player self rates in pickleballbrackets.com, that rating must be confirmed by tournament play or by a RDPC rating. The Club will offer ratings sessions on occasion throughout the summer season.
4. To play in rated play, the following applies: to play in 3.0 rated play, you must be rated at least 3.0; to play in 3.5, you must have at least a 3.5 rating; to play in 4.0, you must have at least a 4.0 rating
5. If a player has reached a tournament rating at some point during this season, they will be allowed to play at that level for the balance of this year. We will not move a player down for the balance of this season. Next spring your most recent pbbrackets rating will be used to determine which skill level group each one will play in. For those players who go south, we will use your utpr if requested.
6. If a person plays in a tournament and their rolling average goes to the next level, they will be invited in to the next level for rated play
