#### **New Business:**

- 5. **Request for Takhini School year 2022-23** Applied for same weekend times as last year and will apply for one more time slot for a weekday evening
- 6. **Review of Mt Mac Courts use** –Staying with M/W/F/S Round Robin at 10:45-12:45 time slot, adding T/T/S Drop play at 10:45-12:45 for up to 20 people
- 7. **CDF-NGO Training Fund for Strat Plan Development.** No word yet from CDF. Hector will contact them, if no response or a negative response by June 13 will file an application for NGO training before Jun 16 as am away for a week after that and the NGO application deadline is June

- 8. **Coaching update** looking for coaches over the summer for the shot clinics.
