2. **Strategic Plan Update**

3. **Mt Mac and Porter Creek Wrap Up**

Mt Mac pickleball court lines have been put in place following the court resurfacing thanks to Hector, Gord and Van. The new yellow lines provide a better contrast. Ian will be asked to restart Signup Genius for the courts at Mt. Mac.

Summer activities at Porter Creek have finished. The shot clinics using the ball machine have been well attended. We have also instructed related drills on the other 2 courts and that has received great feedback. Round Robin open play times we rarely used.

4. Pickleball Fundamentals Fall Course at CGC:

Two courses have been posted in the COW Active Living Guide. Both courses will be for 5 sessions held on Thursdays, 6:00- 7:30 pm.

First session: October 6th – November 3rd.

Second session: November 10th – December 8th

CGC has asked YPA to provide instruction. Brenda will be sending out a note to our existing instructors asking who will be willing to lead and assist with the delivery of the courses.

Many of those who have completed the Pickleball Fundamentals courses have become YPA members.

5. Takhini School Fall Plan

We have the same time slots as last year. Saturday 2:00 -6:00 and Sunday 8:00 am – 3:00 pm from September to June with some exclusions. The Board has decided to keep the fees per semester at \$20. The first weekend will be September 10th-11th with Round Robins on early time slot on both days . Regular programming will start on September 17th-18th.
