



Renew your Membership TODAY – due by December 31, 2022

Membership renewal required before signing up for any of the PRI/QCPH winter programs starting Jan 1, 2023. Other benefits include tournament play, volunteer opportunities, and discounts on QCPH merchandise.

Go to <u>www.pickleballregina.ca</u> click on "Join/Renew", then lookup your member number – choose Pickleball Saskatchewan on the drop-down, then review and update any changes to your personal information, then proceed to sign the waiver and process payment. Or log in to your account on <u>www.pickleballcanada.org</u> and go to "my registrations", then click on Renew Membership.

The \$10 PRI portion of the Membership fees help cover operational expenses being incurred by PRI including providing supplies of pickleballs, repairs and maintenance to the ball machine, supplies and equipment for the outdoor courts at Mahon and Douglas Park.

Pickleball Regina Membership at the Queen City Pickleball Hub

Recent discussions with the Queen City Pickleball Hub have resulted in an agreement that to play in the programs sponsored by both PRI and QCPH, participants will be required to have a current PCO/PSI/PRI membership. This is another step towards the continuation of our journey for both organizations to work together for the benefit of pickleball in the Regina region.

Club Ratings

Pickleball Regina maintains club ratings for all active members. Having this information is useful when creating programs for members. It indicates the types of sessions we should offer and communicates to members what level of play they should expect in any program. Grouping similarly skilled players leads to some of the most exciting and fun games where the outcome could go either way!

Various sources are used to determine a club rating. When more than one exists, the highest available rating is the one that's used for the club rating.

These sources include:

- Skill rating assessments from PRI or the Queen City Pickleball Hub
- Rated PRI ladder leagues (Pickleball Brackets or Global Pickleball Network)
- Sanctioned tournament ratings (<u>CTPR</u> or <u>UTPR</u>)
- Existing club ratings

****IMPORTANT:** The highest rating from any of the above sources is what's used to determine your club rating, *including previous club ratings*. That means that your club rating will never go down through tournaments or ladder play. However, if you do achieve a *higher* rating through ladder play, that will become your new club rating.

2023 Pickleball Canada National Championship

Planning is continuing for the 2023 National Championship coming to Regina on August 23-27, 2023 as we have less than 250 days until the tournament starts.

Recently the official logo was approved and released. You will see this logo often over the coming months as we work towards the Nationals tournament.



With up to 700 athletes and 300 volunteers, this event will showcase pickleball for Canada. Registration starts May 15, 2023. Go to pickleballbrackets.com for more information.
