Touch lock box:

- If door is locked to our Pickleball space use the touch lock box located on the facility door.

- Please ensure door is closed behind you. You can turn the latch to lock the door when you are inside. If you are the last one using the facility ensure door is closed then touch the Yale logo and enter code.
