The cost is \$15.00 for the court and should be paid cash to your Host on arrival. No shows will be charged the \$15 as you are taking a court from other users!!!! This was a wee bit of a problem last year. Please do not book a court and then cancel one day before as it really prevents someone else from having the time to arrange their players.



2023 Club Membership Fees

It is time to renew our membership fees for 2023 which will be increasing to \$40.00. You will pay your club membership fee, your Pickleball BC and Canada membership fee directly thru the PCNS website. If you are a new member who joined the club after Oct 1st, 2022 you will have already paid your Pickleball Canada and Pickleball BC dues for 2023 and will only have to pay your \$40 club membership fees. Please follow the directions below to pay your membership dues. Please understand that membership fees are non-refundable.

- 2. That will take you to the club page where you will see a Join/Renew tab. Click that and follow the instructions for renewing your membership.

- All members will click the second option "I am already or am renewing my membership with Pickleball Canada. This is important as you only want to have one Pickleball Canada number!
- NB: You can add another registrant onto your registration eg. Spouse. If doing this you will see a "Share Field" tab.
- You will now be directed to the Confirmation and Payment pg.
- Payment can be made by both credit and debit cards.
- Membership fees are <u>due Jan 1st, 2023</u> and registration will open on <u>Dec 1st, 2022 @ 8.00am.</u>

6 Week Winter Ladder League

Where: The Landing

When: January 28th-Mar 4th, 2023

Time: 10.30am-12.15pm (NB: This may change a wee bit)

Cost: Players will Fob in as usual (as per normal play) and also pay a one off \$10.00 entry fee to go toward door prizes.)

The format of play is designed so that players play mostly with others of similar skill levels therefore players will be seeded before commencement. Each week in each grouping the top player in the group will move up the ladder and the bottom player will move down.

Each week, players will be placed in groups of 4 or 5 in the order of their ranking on the ladder for match play. You are expected to play every week unless you "Opt Out". All players will play in a round robin fashion with the other players in the group.

The ladder is designed to run for 6 weeks. Players are expected to play all 6 weeks and should not register if they have to miss more than 2 weeks.

Scores will not affect your club ratings!
