## **Coaching Certification Clinics**

Pickleball Saskatchewan Inc. has approved Level 1 and Level 2 NCCP clinics to be held at the Queen City Pickleball Hub in Regina this spring.

### Dates:

Level 2 - (May 11 and 12; a two-day course with a minimum of 8 participants). Level 1 - (May 13; a one-day course with a minimum of 8 participants).

Participants of these clinics will receive a \$150 subsidy from Pickleball Saskatchewan once they produce their certificate of completion.

## 2023 Pickleball Canada National Championship

Planning is continuing for the 2023 National Championship coming to Regina on August 23-27, 2023 as we have less than 220 days until the tournament starts.



With up to 700 athletes this event will showcase pickleball for Canada. Open registration starts May 14, 2023. Go to pickleballbrackets.com for more information.
