Check and Set up Your Pickleball Canada Number

Lyle sent out an email early in January requesting that members check to see if their PCO # was entered into their Pickleball Brackets Profile. Over half of our membership still do not have their PCO# in their Pickleball Brackets Profile. This is going to cause you and us continued stress and frustration as we move forward thru the year, especially when you want to register for a new session or event. Please check your Pickleball Brackets Profile and if you have not entered your PCO # yet please do so ASAP.

Here is how to find your PCO# and attach it to your pickleball brackets account.

Go to the Pickleball Canada website.

Log in with your email address and password-

- On the left-hand side of the page click on "My Profile"
- Your name and PCO number along with other info will appear on the left side of the window
- copy your PCO number

Go to the Pickleballbrackets.com website

- Log in with your email address and password
- Make sure your name appears in the top right-hand corner of the home screen (if it doesn't you are not logged in)
- Click on the "v" beside your name
- C on my profile
- Scroll down to "Section 6. Associated Numbers"
- Continue down to "Pickleball Canada #"
- If your number is recorded there leave it and just exit the program.
- If not enter your PCO number and click on the green "Save Profile" tab at the top of the page.
- This will help keep your Pickleball Brackets account current and enable you to check your ratings and stats.

Skills and Drills

Commencing the month of March, we will be separating signup for skills & drills into two different skill levels.

level 1. - 2.75 and under club rating (16 Players) level 2 - 2.75 and over club rating (8 Players)

Skills & Drills, 2.75 and over will show up as a new session so it will not show up under your "My Schedule" until you actually register. After you register it will then show in your "My Schedule" and then all you have to do is OPT IN for the days you want to attend.
