

2023 National Pickleball Advisory Council (NPAC) Report for 2023 YPA AGM

2022 was a busy year for the advisory council. PCO members has now surpassed 40,000 members in Canada.

Several changes at PCO Canada will affect the Yukon Pickleball Association:

1/ Full implementation of website software to integrate provincial/territorial and club website hosting and design linked to Pickleball Canada website was done in 2022. This is a free service for small jurisdictions like Yukon. YPA have migrated their website over to the PCO website and are using their website administration software to run it.

2/ Full Implementation of event organizing software, free for small jurisdictions like Yukon was done in 2022. YPA have migrated their event booking from Sign Up Genius to PCA's Event Organizer software for Takhini School Court Bookings and events such as Ladder League play, Round Robins and Shot Clinics.

3/Work on updating PCO bylaws remains a work in progress.

4/PCO is currently revising its screening and safe play related policies to reflect the new requirements by the Minister of Sports for adherence to Safe Play federal policies for all national sport governing bodies. YPA will be developing new policies in this area in 2023 as soon as PCO approve their new policies.
