## Ladder Leagues

WBPC is organizing separate intermediate male and female ladder leagues. A pickleball ladder is a system for ranking individuals based on the tracked number of matches they win or lose. As individuals play others, they gain or lose points. The more points an individual has, the higher on the ladder they climb. Think of it as King/Queen of the Court. This will help people to establish and identify others who are at their skill level, and provide more competitive, and social play for our members. There will be a small charge of \$20 per player to participate in the league for the entire season. As we only have four courts, registration will be limited and restricted to those above the 3.0 level. If this is a success, we will plan more ladder leagues in the 2024 season.
