Quick overview:

- Invitations will come from Red Deer Pickleball Club *reddeerpickleballclub@gmail.com as events are established*. If you don't receive an invitation from us, we ask that you check your Junk Email box. When you receive an invite to a sign up for an event, you can sign up with or without creating an account.
- The events will be also be posted on the Red Deer Pickleball Club website.
- Organizers will check the event Sign Up to monitor if they have enough participants to go ahead or if it needs to be cancelled.
- When there is a Sign Up Event you <u>can not</u> just show up expecting to join as in some cases there are limits on registrations, costs for the event or other requirements.

- If you need to cancel you need to delete your registration so others can join.
