

DPA Competitive Ladder Play League



Welcome to the start of the DPA Ladder League. We are looking for players who want to play some competitive Pickleball at all levels. All players will be grouped into specific “pods” based on rating. The ratings will be scrutinized by the league coordinator to ensure fair play at the beginning of the season.

There will be a nominal \$2 fee per player per session.

We are hoping to have up to four or five sessions per week. Two or three in the evenings during the week and two on the weekend to ensure everyone has a chance to play. Players will be permitted to sign up for 1 session per week. In the event one of the sessions is not full, players can sign up for a second session 24 hours before the session is to run. We are planning to use Cromie, Memorial and Chalmers Parks.

There will be a court host at each session. **All scores of every game must be recorded prior to the start of the next game.** All scores will be given to the host to be recorded online after every session. Ratings will then update every week to move everyone up or down the “Ladder”.

Everyone can play as often or as little as their schedule allows. A player’s rating will not be affected if they do not play. If a player misses multiple weeks of play, they will be moved to an “inactive” list but will still maintain their rating and can resume play when their schedule allows.

The format of play will be the same as the CNPL, (National Canadian Pickleball League) and MLP, (Major League Pickleball).

The games will be “rally point” to 21. The rules and format are attached. Please read and/or watch the tutorial video prior to your first session so as to be ready to play.
