Lou Rodrigues, Captain Team - The Picklers Pickleball is not a sport. It's a way of life. We play hard because it's in our soul. Pickle on!




Dorothy Crump, Captain Team - The Red LOBsters

PEEVISH POINTS Challenge

WHO DOESN'T LOVE TO WIN AND REALLY "PEEVE" OFF YOUR OPPONENTS?

"ATP" AROUND THE POST A legal shot whereby the ball is returned from outside the court and into the opposing team's court, never passing over the net. May pass below the level of the top of the net.

GOLDEN PICKLE Winning a game using solely the very first server, with the opposing team never serving.

Serving into the body (or paddle) of the partner of the receiver which results in a point for the server due to interference rules.

Court Etiquette Reminders

Pickleball is fun, but situations do come up in our beloved game that can cause frustration, annoyance and even anger. Poor sportsmanship can ruin a great day on the courts. You don't want to inadvertently become "that person" no one wants to play with.

Here are some common scenarios and tips for dealing with them in social play:

"Out!": A familiar call in pickleball that can cause so much frustration. The old adage is: "When in doubt, call it in." Not out. In social play, you can always play the point over, but it seems lately that social play has gotten very competitive. Remember, lines are in.

Lobbing into the sun versus your opponent in social play: Do not do this. You can solve the problem by switching sides at six points.

Partner response to a player error: If your partner makes a mistake, remember, they already feel bad. Do not roll your eyes, shrug, make any exaggerated physical gestures. The best response would be to say, "next time," or "almost," and when in doubt, just go over and bump your partner's paddle.

The bottom line: Everyone who plays with you should look forward to it, feel good, have fun, and be able to win or lose graciously. Compliment your partner, but do not forget to compliment the other team on a great shot, or a great rally, no matter who won the point.

"CODE OF ETHICS" FOR LINE CALLS IN PICKLEBALL

 Only make line calls on your side of the pickleball court and always strive for accuracy

Only call "out" balls when space is clearly visible between the line and where the pickleball lands

Call "out" balls promptly

Use voice and/or hand signals to call "out" balls

5. Give the benefit of doubt to your opponents

6. If you and your partner disagree, the ball is "in"

7. Spectators should not make any line calls

Do not question opponents' line calls unless there is a referee

9. You may ask your opponents to make a line call (but you give up your right to make the call and, if your opponents cannot make the call, the call will be "in")

10. An "out" call prior to the pickleball bouncing will be deemed partner communication and not a line call

11. You may overrule a line call that is to your disadvantage (and in favor of your opponents) at any time
