# **Upcoming Play Events for 2024**

### **CPC Winter Ladder League**

Jan. 6<sup>th</sup> – Feb. 24<sup>th</sup>, 2024 (No games Feb. 3<sup>rd</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup>) Saturday Mornings from 10:15- 12:15

Cost: Players will Fob in as usual (as per normal play) and also pay a one-of \$10.00 entry fee to go towards door prizes. Register on Pickleball Brackets

#### **General Information for Ladder Leagues**

The format of play is designed so that players play mostly with others of similar skill levels therefore players will be seeded before commencement. Each week in each grouping the top two players in the group will move up and the bottom two players will move down.

Each week, players will be placed in groups of 4, 5 or 6 in the order of their ranking on the ladder for match play. You are expected to play every week unless you "Opt Out". All players will play three or four doubles games in a round robin fashion with the other players in the group. At the start of the game, players will decide who starts serving first and choice of side.

After your games have been played, players record their scores on the score sheet and the ladder captain will then enter them into the pickleball brackets program.

Scores will not affect your club ratings unless a grouping decides that they would like their scores recorded. All players in the group must be in agreeance and be within .5 in skill level.

- NB: Fall Ladder League winners will be determined by most wins. In the event of a tie then it will go to point differential.
  - Winter Ladder League's winner will be determined by the player who finishes at the top of the ladder.

## **CPC January Team Challenge**

Monday, Jan. 8<sup>th</sup>, 2024 Winning Team receives \$100 each Player Maximum 4 Teams consisting of 2 Men & 2 Women.

Each teams total combined club rating must be between 10.00 & 12.00 and there cannot be more than a 1 point differential between the highest and lowest rated player.

Only the Captain needs to register their team. In the event a sub is needed it will be the captain's responsibility to find a sub who qualifies under the above rated guideline.

# Mixed Winter Ladder League Information

### Starting: Mon. Jan 15th and run for 11 weeks until Mar 25th. Time, 3.30-6.30pm.

**Cost**: Normal fob in every week.

**Who can play?** The league is open to all members of all levels, and you will need to have your own mixed partner. The aim is for all teams to enjoy playing pickleball with other teams of a similar skill level.

#### Do teams need to attend all 11 weeks?

No, teams do not have to commit to playing all 11 weeks but there will be a 1 place ranking penalty for missed weeks. Teams can also start mid session but will incur the 1 spot penalty for each week they missed.

#### How does the ladder work?

- You must have a partner as this ladder is set doubles.
- Teams will be placed in groups of 4-5 with other teams closest to them in ranking.
- Format is a round robin. Groups of 4 will play games to 15 win by 2. Groups of 5 will play games to 11 win by 2. One 1min timeout per team per game.
- After play is finished, the team's scores are entered. The rankings are recalibrated for the next week and the top team of the group will move up and the bottom team will move down.
- If a team misses a week, then they will incur a 1 spot penalty.
- After the 11 weeks are complete there will be a prize awarded to the top team.
- If you require a sub, then that player may not have a higher club rating than the player they are subbing for.

#### How do I register?

- Both team members need to register on Pickleball Brackets on the Mixed Doubles League. You must do this before you will see it listed under your "My Schedule". If you are having problems, please contact Carol at treasurer@chillpb.com.
- You must OPT IN on Pickleball Brackets one week in advance up to 2hrs before play commences.





• If you cannot play then you must OPT OUT 2hrs before play commences. It is very important to arrive on time so not to delay play.

#### What happens when the round robin is finished?

Teams may continue playing socially and mixing with other teams one court up or down. Please be considerate of all players and do not leave your court short of players.

Lastly have fun and see you on the courts!

Format: Men's, Women's & Mixed Doubles, Round Robin - Skill Levels:-2.0 & under (Any Age ) 2.5 (Any Age & 50yrs & 0ver) 3.00 (Any Age & 50yrs and over) 3.5 (Any Age & 50yrs & Over) 4.0 - 4.5 (Men Any Age & 50yrs and Over - Women Any Age Only )

Early Bird Registration Fee: \$50.00 plus \$15.00 per event. (Chilliwack Club Members cost is \$40.00 for registration and \$15.00 per event). Late Registration after Jan 8th , 1.00am: \$60.00 and \$50 for club members.

NOTE: All Registration thru Pickleball Brackets. Players must be at least 12yrs of age.
