General housekeeping information

If you haven't already done so, it's time to renew your membership fees for 2024. You will pay your club membership fee, your Pickleball BC and Canada membership fee directly thru the PCNS website. If you are a new member who joined the club after Oct 1st, 2023 you will have already paid your Pickleball Canada and Pickleball BC dues for 2024 and will only have to pay your \$40 club membership fees. Play Credit Information:

You have to be a Club member to purchase Play Credits for the Sports Landing. There are several rates to purchase:

\$50.00 - 10 Play Credits \$75.00 - 17 Play Credits \$125.00 - 30 Play Credits

Members can e-transfer an amount to pay@chillpb.com

Play Credits will be credited to your account. E-transfer is setup with your bank and pay@chillpb.com is where the transfer is sent. Our bank uses Autodeposit so no password is needed. If your bank requires a password use the word Pickleball.

We are making an effort to reduce the amount of cash that the Club has to deal with. However, you can still bring cash or cheques to the check-in table. We realize that for some people e-transfer is not an option.

IMPORTANT: MAKE SURE THAT YOU ARE INDICATING IN THE 'MEMO' SECTION OF YOUR E-TRANSFER THE NAME OF THE PLAYER (OR PLAYERS) THAT YOU ARE PURCHASING PLAY CREDITS FOR, AND HOW MUCH SHOULD BE ALLOCATED TO EACH (IF THERE IS MORE THAN ONE).

NB: Playing Credits are Non-Transferable and Non-Refundable

Not only did we have great success running the tournament, but many of our members had great success down on the courts as well!!!







Merchandise/Paddle table

Just a reminder that on Mondays we have the <u>Member's merchandise</u> table available. On Mondays the table will be open for any of our members to display any pickleball related items that they may have for sale. For example, a slightly used paddle, court shoes that are newer but don't really work for you, or other items you have acquired that are in good condition, but you no longer require.

There are a few rules regarding putting items out for sale:

- 1. Items must be pickleball related
- 2. You must put out your product when you arrive, and take it back with you when you leave that day
- 3. Items must be clearly marked with the price, your name, and phone number so that you can be contacted. (People will be able to connect with you at the end of play when you are coming back to the table to collect your items)

Tuesday to Saturdays we will continue to have our demo paddles out, as well as the club's selection of new paddles for purchase. On these days the table will only be displaying paddles being sold by the club, and there will be some demo paddles still available for sign-out if you want to try them out. In order to purchase any of the products being displayed by the club, please inform your host for that day and they will be able to help you or have Ray Hart or Dave Barham, who are in charge of our paddle inventory, secure a paddle for you to purchase. Please note that new paddles, or paddles not marked as Demo, new paddles, or paddles not to be taken out on the court and used during game play. (We have secured some new paddles, at some really great discounted prices, and unfortunately do not have Demo paddles available to try out).






