



Code of Conduct

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- Good sportsmanship shall always be on display.
- Be respectful of the skill levels of all players through positive reinforcement.
- Be respectful of others' play by waiting for a break to move across a court, not distracting your opponents during play, and warning when unsafe situations arise such as ball on court or player safety issues.
- Be respectful of others, if sick stay home.
- Good-natured ribbing and taunts shall be limited in nature, with no ill-natured remarks.
- Ensure all guests are well informed of Club rules of play and Code of Conduct.
- Profanity, intimidation, bullying or any form of abuse towards others is not permitted.
- Club and venue equipment is not to be abused. Additionally, handling of personal equipment (e.g. paddles) shall be used in a fashion to ensure the safety of others at all times.
- Impairment due to alcohol or other substances shall not be tolerated.
- Failure to follow this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action being taken by the Shediac Pickleball Club Executive Committee. This disciplinary action can range from a warning, suspension, or revocation of an individual's Shediac Pickleball Club membership.
