The policy outlines the principles and practices BVPA follows in protecting members’ personal information.

Scope

This Policy will apply to all BVPA members, guests, underage players and non-members and to any entity which provides services on BVPA’s behalf.

Collection of Information


BVPA collects information including members’ names, ages, addresses, telephone numbers, pickleball rating and emergency contact information. This information is collected from:

- Member registrations
- Donors and sponsors of events

Use of Information

BVPA collects only the personal information needed for the purpose of better serving club members and expanding community support. This includes:

- Provision of information about events, membership and scheduled play
- For service phone calls and emails to members as needed
- For audit purposes

Disclosure of Information

BVPA treats its obligations with respect to the use and disclosure of members’ personal information very seriously. BVPA will only use or disclose personal information for the primary purpose for which it was collected or for a purpose that members would reasonably expect it to be used. BVPA members shall not use other members’ personal information for purposes other than purposes supported and approved by BVPA.
