- **1. 55+ Canada Games:** Team Yukon heads to Quebec City next week to play in a wide array of events. The Pickleball contingent consists of 27 players participating in Men's, Women's, and Mixed Doubles events at the 3.0 and 3.5 skill levels. Have fun!
- **2. Summer Programming:** Our indoor programming at Ecole Emile Tremblay is over. Outdoor programming continues at Mt. Mc. Over 100 of our members purchased a Mt. Mc. pass or purchased a Tennis Yukon pass this summer. We will continue using the courts as long as the weather is reasonable, with essentially the same playing options: open round robins, up/down round robins, and group bookings. The 55+ Canada Games training times on Sunday evenings will be over and will be replaced with open round robin play.
- **3. Fall Programming:** As mentioned in the last newsletter we have programming options every day of the week this fall. To access these activities, you need to purchase a fall pass for \$40. You can purchase the pass on-line at our webpage (left side). Fall activities commence on Thursday September 12 from 8-10 pm at the university gym. Signing up for events will be from our webpage, with separate drop-down menus for the various venues: University, Elijah Smith, Takhini, and Hidden Valley.

For September and **for the four-hour blocks**, namely: on Fridays at E. Smith from 5-9 pm, on Saturdays at Takhini from 2-6 pm, the first two hours will be scheduled for open round robins (max 15). The second 2 hours will be scheduled for 3 group bookings.

As well, **for the two-hour blocks**: namely on Tuesdays and Thursdays at the University, from 8-10 pm and on Monday and Wednesdays from 6-8 pm at Hidden Valley the events will be open round robin.

On Sundays at Takhini, until Pickleball Brackets Ladder League is initiated, we will have a tiered round robin event. The 9-11 am slot will be for 3.5 level players. The 11 am to 1 pm slot will be for 3.0 level players. And the 1-3 pm slot will be for 2.5 level players.
