Instruction will be divided into three levels:

## Level 1 (2.0-3.0) - Introduction to Pickleball

At this level basic skills will be taught to develop your game to transition Level 2

- Rules of the game
- Serve/Return of serve
- Basic 3<sup>rd</sup> shot drop
- Forehand/backhand directional technique
- Volleys
- Court positioning

## Level 2 (3.0-3.75) - Learning to Compete

At this level players will begin to learn more advanced shots to compete at the 3.5+ level

- 3<sup>rd</sup> shot drop, topspin and slice
- 3<sup>rd</sup> shot drive
- Advanced dinking topspin, slice, directional changes
- Topspin, slice and punch volley
- Offensive and defensive lobs

## Level 3 (3.75+) - Advanced Skills and Techniques for High Level Players

This is for players that want to take their game to the highest level and compete in 4.0+ tournaments

- Misdirect
- 2 handed backhand
- Flick shot
- Topspin speedup
- Poaching
