January Play Sessions

Regular play sessions:

January's play calendar is now up on our Club website (Chillpb.com) and is also attached to the end of this newsletter. Club Play sessions will continue once a week for 3.0 & over as well as 2.99 and under. We have also been able to continue to include an open Club play session each week which is for any club rating. Skills & Drills will continue on Thursdays at 2:45-4:30 except for Thursday, Jan. 2nd when it will run from 3:00-5:00. There is also Book Your Own Court sessions on 4 of the 5 Friday afternoons.

Men's and Women's Mixer:

This month we have two dates for the women's and men's mixer events, Tuesday, Jan. 7th and Tuesday, Jan. 14th. Both sessions run from 12:30-3:00 pm.

Men's and Women's Set Doubles:

On Tuesday, Jan 21st and Tuesday, Jan. 28th we will see the return of our Set Doubles play. Find a women's or men's partner and sign up to play from 12:30–3:00.

Beginners and 70+ Social play:

If you are a beginner player at the club, or any member that is 70+, we have set aside a play session just for you! The session will run every Tuesday in January (7th, 14th, 21st, and 28th) from 3:00 - 5:00.

Drill and Play Session with Alistair Hart:

There is still space available in the 2.5 - 3.5 sessions that run on Mondays afternoons from 3:30 - 6:00. Please contact Carol Hart if you have any questions.

6 Week Winter Ladder Play for all Members:

Our new Winter Ladder League will run from January 6th – February 10th on Monday mornings from 10:30am-1:00pm. Players will Fob in as usual (as per normal play) and also pay a one off \$10.00 entry fee to go toward door prizes.) Register on SignUpHub.

General Information for Ladder Leagues

The format of play is designed so that players play mostly with others of similar skill level therefore players will be seeded before commencement. Each week in each grouping the top two players in the group will move up and the bottom two players will move down.

Each week, players will be placed in groups of 4, 5 or 6 in the order of their ranking on the ladder for match play. You are expected to play every week. PLEASE DONT SIGN UP FOR THE LADDER LEAGUE UNLESS YOU CAN COMMIT TO PLAYING IN AT LEAST 4 OF THE 6 SESSIONS. All players will play three or four doubles games in a round robin fashion with the other players in the group. At the start of the game, players will decide who starts serving first and choice of side. After your games have been played, players record their scores on the score sheet and the ladder captain will then enter them

After your games have been played, players record their scores on the score sheet and the ladder captain will then enter them into the pickleball brackets program. Scores will not affect your Club ratings. The Ladder League winners will be the player who finishes in the top spot and the player who has moved the most up the ladder.

Chilliwack Club Finals:

On Friday, Jan. 17th, from 6:30-10:30pm we will be holding our first CPC Club Finals. The top 8 ranked male, and top 8 female, players have been invited to participate. There will be separate play-offs for both the men and women in which they will play a round robin to seed them into partners, and then a final round robin to determine the winning teams. If you are not a participant and would like to watch some great pickleball games, you are welcome to come join us as spectators!

-Make sure you are wearing good court shoes when you come to play. This concrete floor needs footwear with that provide good grip and that support your feet and ankles well.


-Please protect your eyes when on the court. Pickleball eye injuries continue to be on the rise.
