



March Play session updates and changes:

For the month of March, we have made a few changes to our schedule. (A copy of the March play calendar is attached at the end of this newsletter and can also be found on our Club website). We will continue with Mixers, Book Your Own Court (BYOC), and Monday Drill&Play sessions with Alistair Hart, but have made a slight change to Club play as there will only be one 2.9+over and one 2.8+under session each week, and no Open Club play sessions. The following are some other additions to the March Calendar that you should be aware of:

2 Up/ 2 Down:

In the month of March we will be re-introducing the format of **2 Up**/**2 Down** into the schedule. For the first half of the session, you will play timed Round-robin games on your allocated court. After that Round-robin is complete, the top 2 ranked players on the court will move up a court, the bottom 2 ranked players will move down a court, and the middle-ranked player will not move. (see calendar for specific dates and times)

Men's, Women's and Mixed Set Doubles:

Men's & Women's Set Doubles is scheduled for **Thurs, March 20th** and Mixed Set Doubles is scheduled for **Thurs, Mar 27th**, so organize your partner and register on SUH.

Partner Drills for players 3.5 Club Rating and over :

Organize a partner and sign up to drill on **Mon, Mar 31st**. You can follow along with Raymond & Carol Hart or do your own drills. This is not an instructional session, and NO Games are allowed as there will be balls flying around everywhere!!!! Cost: 2 play credits each player. Only 5 courts available.

CPC Mayday Team Challenge When: Sat May 10th, 2025 Where: The Landing Time: Bracket 1 & 2 (8.30am-1.30pm). Bracket 3 & 4 (2.00pm-7.00pm) Cost: \$250 per team. Lunch and snacks will be provided. Registration Deadline: April 26th, 2025 ***CPC Members will have priority registration until Mar 2nd, 2025*** Winning Team from each bracket receives \$400 (\$100 each Player). Maximum 24 Teams consisting of 2 Men & 2 Women. (there cannot be more than a 1-point rating differential between the highest and lowest rated (DUPR) player on the team) Teams will be split into 4 brackets by average team rating based on DUPR ratings. Only the Captain needs to register their team. In the event a sub is needed it will be the captain's responsibility to find a sub who fits the guidelines stated below. -Registration on Pickleball Canada. Only team captain needs to register and submit payment. -Ctrl & Click Link to register:- Chilliwack Pickleball Club Mayday Team Challenge -Team roster and team name must be submitted to Tournament Director by April 26th, 2025. ***Players who are interested in participating but do not have a team may put their name on the board (CPC Members Only)***

Club Operation Updates:

****New Club rule change**:** From now on the club rules will designate that the **green curtain**, on courts 4 and 11, and the **wires**, **that hang down** near courts 9 and 10, are **permanent objects**. As such, the rule will be that if a ball hits one of these permanent objects, it will become a dead ball and it will be seen as a FAULT. In other words, if you strike a ball and it makes contact, with either of these objects, it will be seen as a fault against your team, it will no longer be a reserve.

Play credit arrears: If your play credits get used up and you are in a negative balance situation you will be unable to sign up for play sessions on SUH once you have reached -5 credits. Credits are easy to purchase online on SUH, so please try and keep your account up to date.

DUPR scores: Some members have been asking about having club scores entered into DUPR. If you and your court of 4 or 5 members are in a club play session, **and prior to the session beginning,** you have **all** agreed to enter your games into your DUPR accounts, you can go ahead and make a note of your scores and then go home and enter them into DUPR.

Used Nets: The club purchased some new nets prior to our last tournament and as a result we have a few used nets to sell. If you are interested, please get in touch with Ray Hart.



Important Reminders:

-Please try and stay for sessions until the end, when you leave early it often leaves courts short of players. We also often see people leaving Club play as soon as their Club games are finished.... there is still lots of great pickleball left afterwards (sometimes even more fun since the pressure is off!!) so please plan to stay and play!


-Some members are very sensitive, or even allergic to fragrances or colognes. Please remember to be aware of this before you attend a play session.


