

- In 2024 we switched from Learn to Play, Pickle Skills to Drills and Skills Thursdays. Bryan Weber continued with the Leagues. All were well attended. Special thanks to Bryan, Doug, Cathy and all the volunteer instructors for your leadership and assistance making these programs a success for our Club.
