Cromie Park Update

Most of you have been following the progress at Cromie Park and know of some of the mis-steps of the original contractor. Thankfully we asked the City to work with the same surfacing company that did both Dennison and Chalmers, and they have now taken the lead on surface finishing, base coat painting, court surface painting and then lines. Much of this finishing work is dependent on dry weather and when they get the appropriate window, they will complete this work, and the new courts will be available to us. We continue to have good relationships and communication with the City and are thankful for this good partnership.

Membership Renewals

Thank you to all of you for renewing your membership. We are almost at the number of members that we ended 2024 and hope to soon eclipse that number. If you have not renewed, we would ask you to please do so as soon as you can. With a municipal election occurring next year it is important that we show the City how vibrant and committed the pickleball community is.

We have also held 4 mentor sessions designed to help those players wanting to advance in their skills, tactics and understanding on the game. Additional thanks go out to Ray, Doug, Ann, Dave, Cheryl, and Kim for stepping up as Volunteer coaches. Without their help this wouldn't be possible. Please remember that members are only allowed to sign up for one player development session per club season to ensure more people have access.

Scheduling and Club Operations

To keep our club running smoothly, please remember a few things during your DPA sessions:

• Please exit the courts promptly when the time of your session ends regardless of the score. This ensures that the next session gets their complete time. If public courts are available, please feel free to "paddle up" for public courts to compete your game.

• Please sign up for only one DPA session per day. This allows everyone to sign up for sessions;

• If you need to cancel, please cancel well in advance so that others can sign up for that time slot and the sessions can fill up appropriately.

Summary

Your Board is excited to continue to work to improve the offerings and operations of our club. We have adopted a philosophy of trying new things. If these things are popular and helpful to our club, then we can look to expand these offerings. If sessions or schedules are not working, then we can change and offer something different.
