# INDOOR FACILITIES & PLAY





We had an incredible winter season of pickleball! Returning to King Square Sport Centre (KSSC), our indoor sessions were a hit. This year, we also introduced exciting new venues: **Unionville Badminton Complex (UBC)** and **The Bridge Community Church**.

From November 2024 to April 2025, MPC organized four 9week, 2-hour weekday programs at KSSC, utilizing three courts. We also held 9-week, 2-hour programs on Saturday and Sunday afternoons at UBC, and an 8-week, 2-hour program on Wednesday evenings at The Bridge. Our participants loved the sessions at UBC and The Bridge, giving us fantastic feedback.

With the opening of our outdoor courts, the number of indoor programs has decreased. However, for May-June, we continue to offer an 8-week program at KSSC for novice players and 8-week programs on Saturday and Sunday afternoons at UBC.
