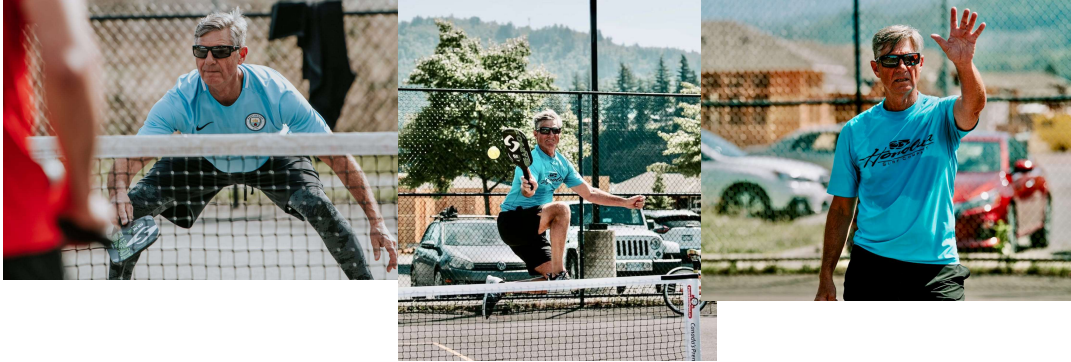


Condolences

July 9th, 2024, 6:30-9:30pm

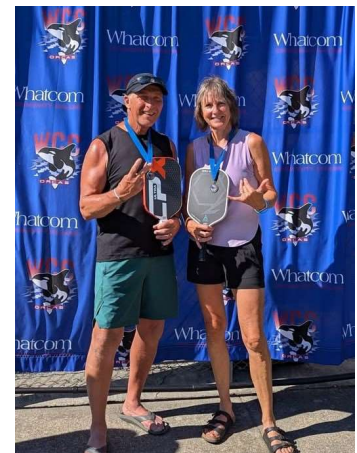
Location: Upstairs at the Chilliwack Curling Club
