Dream Maker Round Robin – August 9 - Major League Pickleball format

When:

This year **August 9 2025** is **"National Pickleball Day"** in Canada. The DPA welcomes you to come join us for a fun and social day of Round Robin Play with your fellow Pickleballers!

We are so excited to show off our new courts in Ladner and have a fun day of team play similar to what you would see in Major League Pickleball.

Where:

• Cromie Park, Ladner, 4907 42B Avenue

How does it work:

- With the primary goal being to have fun and enjoy the company of members within our club, we will be putting together **random mixed teams** based upon registrations. To ensure that all teams are relatively equally competitive, we will not be allowing teams to register together.
- Teams will be formed consisting of **six players from 3 different skill groups** (two players per skill group). While there will be different skill groups on teams, you will only play with and against players within your skill group. This is important to ensure that people are comfortable playing within their games.
- Teams will participate in games collectively with each "skill group" taking the court to play against the same skill level of player on the opposing team. Each skill group will play five points after which players will "swap out" and hand the court over to their teammates at the next skill level. This MLP format is known for great teamwork and cheering on the rest of your team while they play.
- Games will be played in a **Rally Point Format to 21**. Rally point scoring is different from traditional scoring in that each rally played awards a point to the rally winning team regardless of who is serving.
- Play will be a collection of round robin games against the various other teams participating.
- Teams should expect to play about 8 games depending on registrations, etc.

How do I Join ?

- We will be setting up registration on **Play Time Scheduler** by skill group: 2-2.5, 2.75-3.0, 3.25, 3.5,3.75, 4.0+
- Teams will then be built, and it is important that if you sign up that you can actually attend as your Team will be built and will be relying on you given the format.

• **Registration will open on July 19** and will close on August 1st. Please watch for it on PTS and sign up early as we need to get an early picture of people's interest.

Entry Fee:

- We will be charging a \$20.00 non-refundable fee for players that are members. If you are not a member and would like to play, you will have to join first prior to entering the Round Robin.
- Your entry fee gets you lunch (a Sandwich, Snack, and a drink) with any remaining funds going to the Delta Community Animal Shelter.
- Once you have registered on Playtime Scheduler, please send an e transfer to *treasurer@deltapickleball.org*.
- We need to have prepayment as we are committing to lunch costs, etc.

It would be great if we were able to fill the courts and the areas around Cromie with tents, chairs, blankets, etc. Remember that we now have great facilities for restrooms, etc. on site at Cromie. Remember to sign up early.
