



RESPONSIBILITIES

As a valued member of the Yukon Pickleball Association, you are kindly expected to fulfill a few important responsibilities that help ensure a positive experience for all. Members are asked to pay annual membership dues and any applicable facility fees, and to complete registration through the secure Pickleball Canada online portal. Everyone is encouraged to follow venue rules, such as respecting scheduled play times and assisting with equipment setup and takedown. Additionally, members are expected to promote fair play, foster a respectful environment, and acknowledge the traditional territories on which we play. Your cooperation and involvement help strengthen the YPA community for everyone.

BOOKINGS

Facility times become available to book online on Sundays at 7pm for the following week. During the winter, slots fill quickly and the association may ask members to refrain from booking too many slots throughout the week on Sundays so as to create an equal opportunity for all to have some court time. Please keep an eye on your emails for newsletters from YPA to stay in the loop on these guidelines. 



OPEN ROUND ROBIN



SCAN TO SIGN UP

- Fun and organized format where a player of any skill level plays against a variety of others.
- Players rotate courts and partners after each match set time.
- Designed for fair play and equal match opportunities.
- Open RR events are open to all skill levels.
- Individual registration is online via the QR Code or https://secure.pickleballcanada.org/org/yukon-pickleball-association/14/
- On-site, players mark their name on the signup sheet to receive a round robin number.
- Players follow a match chart to play a set number of games with different opponents.
- Matches typically last 13 to 15 minutes.
- Players can play as many games as possible during their match time.
- Games are usually played to 11 points, win by 2.



TIERED ROUND ROBIN



Some round robins are tiered by skill level.

Skill level for our association is based on DUPR ratings.

2.0/2.5 = new to the game, developing basic shot consistency

3.0 = intermediate players with improving strategy and shot control

3.5 = upper intermediate players with consistent ability to perform strategies and have extended rallies Players must register in the appropriate tier (based on current level of play).

If unsure of skill level, start with an Open RR to assess your level.



FACILITATED ROUND ROBIN



SCAN TO SIGN UP

This is a tiered round robin which begins with 30 mins to an hour of instructor led drills.

There are a limited amount of spots available for sign up as the instructors

- want to ensure they can equally assist all individuals who participate.
- Be sure to register for your appropriate skill level.
- All instructors volunteer their time to offer the membership support through these mini drill sessions so be sure to thank them for their time and efforts in organizing these for us!
- Individual players register online by selecting the "Indoor Events Signup".

GROUPS



Similar to round robins, group play refers to <u>organized</u> games involving multiple players rotating through matches, often in a social or skill-building setting. What sets group bookings apart is that it is composed of a specific set of players who have chosen to come together to play and/or drill in a informal setting.

- Groups are typically formed by word of mouth and by those who enjoy similar levels of play.
- In group bookings, you would select one of the courts available and that court would be allocated to your specific group.
- All group members should sign up for their court.
- If you have not previously discussed joining a specific group, you should not add your name to their court.
- Individual players register online by selecting the "Indoor Events Signup" or "Mt Mac Events Signup" (summer only).

Scroll through the drop down for date and time options.

Please establish your group then register for a court.

FAQs

I WANT TO COME AND TRY. CAN I COME TO A FACILITY ONCE TO SEE IF I LIKE IT AND THEN POSSIBLY JOIN THE YPA?

No. For insurance reasons, you need to be a member of YPA to participate in YPA events. For trial purposes, you can do 'drop-in' pickleball at the Canada Games Centre and you can also register for introductory courses through the CGC delivered by YPA instructors.

HOW DO I REMOVE MY NAME (DEREGISTER) FROM AN EVENT?

Scan the QR Code. It will bring you to our main page where you can click the 'Event Deregistration' button, and follow the steps. You will be required to login to the Pickleball Canada website.



IF I HAVE A COMPLAINT ABOUT ANOTHER MEMBER, WHAT SHOULD I DO?

If you have a suggestion or a concern, we kindly encourage you to first speak directly with the individual involved, oneon-one, in a respectful and constructive manner.

Many issues can be resolved through open and honest conversation.

If the matter remains unresolved or requires further attention, you are welcome to bring it to a board member for support.
