Play Level Descriptions



Open Play – All Skill Levels

For players ranging from beginner to experienced. Participants must know the basic rules of the game and be able to engage in regular gameplay with minimal instruction.

Beginner / Novice

For new players and those who have recently taken up the sport. Focus is on learning the fundamentals, developing consistency, and gaining confidence.

Recreational

For new to experienced players who prefer a social, non-competitive environment. Ideal for those not interested in tournament or competitive play.

Intermediate / Advanced

For experienced players seeking competitive, strategy-oriented play. Participants may attend tournaments regularly or be preparing to do so.

Skills & Drills (Self-Guided)

Open practice time for all players. Intended as independent skill-building sessions — instructors are **not** present. Drills and practice plans are available in the onsite binder for your use.

DUPR /MATCH Play-requires pre-registration to ensure enough players. More info is coming prior to Nov 15 start date.

Courts will be assigned DUPR ratings and players will play games within their current DUPR rating.

If players do not have a DUPR rating, they will be assigned to the lower rated court to start.

*Pickleball Canada has officially adopted DUPR (Dynamic Universal Pickleball Rating) as its official rating system, unifying Canadian pickleball players under a single, global rating framework. This partnership aims to provide a more accurate and transparent system for all levels of play, from club events to major tournaments, and will be used for seeding, player development, and fair competition.
