2025 Key Accomplishments

We are thrilled to highlight the following key accomplishments:

Keith King Sports Courts are under construction

With hard work of the Golden Pickleball Club board of directors and the support of our players the courts are almost complete.

These courts will have four pickleball courts, two tennis courts, a practice wall and basketball hoop.

The funding sources for the project are:

Whitetooth Legacy Funding \$194,000

Golden Pickleball Club ReDi grant \$48,550

CSRD Community Works Fund \$500,000

The ReDi grant funded the purchase of all posts and nets for the pickleball and tennis courts, as well as 50% of the Plexipave court surface.

We anticipate that the courts will be finished by July 2026, once the final surface of Plexipave is applied and court lines are applied.

The club would like to thank the Town of Golden, Columbia Shuswap Regional District (CSRD) Area 'A', Columbia Basin Trust, and all of our players.



Pickleball has become a resounding success at Mount 7 Rec Plex. Since 2016, participation has increased dramatically, from 694 visits to an impressive 1,750 visits in the 2024-25 season. This substantial growth highlights the facility's commitment to offering diverse recreational opportunities and meeting the community's growing interest in pickleball.
