

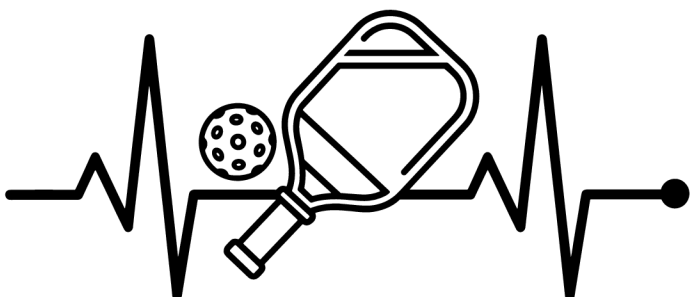

2025 Highlights

- Split cost of divider nets, new court nets, and Fan's
- Hosted a 2 day joint tournament with Pinnacle great turnout considering the weather.
- Helped St. Mary's host a 2-day Seniors Regional Tournament.
- Hosted 4 awesome fun nights with prizes for some costume nights
- Offered our first discount for SPA members that entered our tournament in Nov
- Hosted our first SPA appreciation event with almost 45% of our members attending 20 prizes handed out and a great lunch from Taylor's Delicatessen
- Food Drive and SPA Donated \$250 and Pinnacle matched it. Members donated food and supplies. Combined over 400 lbs of food and supplies donated to the House of Blessing
- Formed a small committee in conjunction with Pinnacle to start a Mixed Monday night league that was strongly brought to our attention through the Survey
- After a lengthy discussion SPA agreed it was time to raise our membership fee by \$5. It's never been raised since SPA was formed.
