WHERE WE PLAY

Outdoor Season (BPPC)

Brown's Paving Pickleball Park (BPPC),
75 Perry Street

- 4 dedicated outdoor courts, structured and open play.
- Access via court Alta Open access app (download from your App Store)
- Seasonal registration opens mid-late April. Season typically runs from early May until October.
- **Seasonal, Monthly and Student memberships** may be purchased through our website.

Indoor Season (Pay-as-you-play)

- \$2.50 per session (subject to change)
- Invoiced monthly to be paid via e-transfer
- Multiple weekly sessions

Playtime Scheduler Required

We use Playtime Scheduler to organize all club sessions. You may use the website or app to create your account!

- Create a free account and be sure to **self-assess your skill rating as a minimum 2.0**, even for beginners.
- The answer to starting score is **0-0-2**
- Sign up for sessions.
- View available playtimes.

Once your account is created, you will receive an invite to join the SPC group.

Levels of Play

SPC is growing fast, and we want to make sure every member finds their "sweet spot" on the court! To help you choose the best sessions for your style, we use the following session categories:

Beginner / Non-Competitive (Levels 2.0 - 3.0)

The Vibe: Fun & Social. Who: You're mastering the rules and scoring, or you just want a relaxed game without the pressure of intense competition.

Intermediate (Levels 2.75 - 3.75)

The Vibe: Active & Improving. Who: You've got the serve down, you're working on those dinks and drops, and you're ready for vigorous, heart-pumping rallies!

Advanced / Competitive (Levels 3.0 - 5.0+)

The Vibe: Fast & Strategic. Who: You use the "third shot drop" as a weapon and have high control over pace and placement. You're here to sharpen your competitive edge.

PLAYER RATINGS (DUPR) Dynamic Universal Pickleball Rating

For those who may be interested in participating in competitive tournaments or DuPR rated sessions within our club or elsewhere, you will need a DuPR account. This may be created at any time.

Used for:

- **Competitive play**
- **Rated sessions**
- **Tournament-style games**



DUPR is not required for beginner or recreational play.

- **Call lines fairly**
- **No unsolicited coaching**
- **Include everyone in rotation**
- **Call “Ball!” when you ball enters someone elses court for safety**
