

Coaldale Pickleball Club: Outdoor Play 2026

Welcome! This reference guide has been created to facilitate our 2026 Outdoor Play season:

Outdoor Play availability:

- Coaldale Pickleball Club (CPC) provided an Outdoor Play schedule at Eastview Courts located at 1825 10 St. There will also be indoor courts available at The Shift Community Recreation Center, 2600 16 Avenue. Outdoor scheduled play will move to the SHIFT Center during inclement weather. Note: there is a small charge (\$5.50 - \$6.75 per day – age dependent).
- We will run scheduled play through Friday from 8:30 am to 1:00 pm. If there is interest, we will also run evening sessions.
- The Club will not be scheduling organized play outside of these parameters
- CPC Outdoor play is limited to current CPC members.

Outdoor play will be organized:

- to ensure a fun and respectful environment
- to provide opportunity for members to play during our scheduled Outdoor hours
- to develop and foster our pickleball community
- to provide opportunities for members to develop skills and improve play level

Safe Play:

- Players are expected to play in a respectful and safe manner at all times
- Ensure courts are completely dry before play
- A first aid kit is available in the CPC locked storage unit
- Report any injuries to the Club representative listed below
- Ensure CPC storage unit is locked at the end of play

Scheduling:

- Outdoor schedule will be posted on Team Reach
- Members can access the CPC Team Reach site by searching for Group Name and then entering the Group code below:
 - Group Name: CPC Members
 - Group code: Coaldale2026
- The schedule will be posted in two week blocks
- Updated weekly schedules will be posted one week in advance of the two week block on Monday at noon.
- Any blocks that are not filled within 48 hours of play may be reassigned to an alternate grouping
- The schedule will be modified over the course of the season based on uptake of sessions and player feedback

- Players are expected to play the assigned play for a specific time period. For example, if a session is scheduled as Ladder play, then it is expected that session will be played as Ladder play
- All sessions will be capped to ensure adequate opportunity to play

Hosts:

- We will have a designated host for all sessions that are larger than 8 players. Hosts will be assigned and listed in the Team Reach schedule. Hosts will be responsible to organize and facilitate play within CPC guidelines.

Weather impact:

- During cooler months, play will be scheduled to begin at 9:00 am
- During hot months, play will be scheduled to begin at 8:30 am
- The courts can be very slippery when wet. Play will be suspended in rain/ wet weather.
- **NEW IN 2026** -Alternate Play option for Inclement weather will be at the SHIFT Community Recreational Center. Check Team Reach to confirm if a session has been moved to the SHIFT center. (Note: there is a small charge (\$5.50 - \$6.75 per day – age dependent).

GUEST Play: NEW IN 2026

- For insurance reasons, the CPC board has instituted a Guest Policy
 - Guests will be welcome to play during CPC scheduled sessions. All guests must be members of Pickleball Canada.
 - Guest names and confirmation of PB Canada membership number must be submitted in writing on Team Reach to Event organizer/scheduler prior to the event.
- Please submit your Guest name on Team Reach to the Club representative listed below a minimum of 48 hours before the scheduled event

Types of Play:

1. Round Robin Play:
 - The intent of Round Robin Play is to foster play within specific ratings group.
 - All participants must have a club rating that matches the designated rating for that session.
 - Players without club rating MAY NOT play in rated play sessions
 - The host will randomly assign numbers to begin play.
2. Open Play:
 - The intent of Open Play is to provide an opportunity for all members regardless of rating to play together in a fun and welcoming environment
 - These sessions are open to all CPC Members
 - The host will randomly assign numbers to begin play

3. Ladder Play:

- The intent of Ladder Play is to encourage fun play and skill development. Ladder Play will start as regular play, and transition to similar skill levels as play advances.
- The host will randomly assign players for first game (eg numbering; playing cards).
- If you win, you and your partner move up to the next court, and split to play with new partners
- If you lose, you and your partner move down to the next court, and split to play with new partners
- The two players that don't win on Court #4, will sit out the next game, and then split and re-enter on court #4 the following game.

4. Partner Play:

- The intent of Partner Play sessions is to provide opportunity for partners to play together.
- Each partner must sign up for the session. Partners will play together for the entire session
- Single players may sign up and indicate that they need a partner. If a partner is not found, then they will not be able to play in this session
- The host will randomly assign numbers to begin the session
