

**Waiver to Access TRIDON Pickleball Courts and
Opening & Closing Instructions**
Revised April 15, 2026

*For **any member** who wishes to access the courts including: OSP Court Convener, Program Leaders, Social Committee Members, Directors, Authorized & Certified Coaches, & Committee Members & members etc.*

1. If the brown metal driveway gate is closed, swing it open and secure it with the pin.
2. Open the clubhouse using the confidential CODE. The key to the padlock is hung high on the inside of the clubhouse doorframe. **Be sure to return the key to this location.** (If the lock does not work, press the centre lock button 3 times and try the code again.)
3. With the assistance of other players, do any court clean up needed for safe play.
4. If the courts are unsafe or inclement weather is expected, cancel the time slot using GBPC WhatsApp chat.
5. Set up the portable nets if needed.
6. Put the red Automated External Defibrillator (AED) on the table in plain sight.
7. Ensure the leaf blower batteries are returned to the chargers after use.
8. For Open Social Play, set up the WIN, LOSE, NEXT cards on the convener table.
9. Check shoe tags are being worn. **(Uninsured persons are not permitted inside the court fencing or on the property).**
10. Encourage court etiquette e.g., wait for a pause in a game before moving to the convener's table.
11. Leave the portable nets up if good weather is forecasted. Release the tension on the nets by loosening the velcro straps. Ask all players to check their pockets for forgotten balls and return the balls to the ball holders.
12. If the weather is questionable at the end of your time, take the portable nets down. Check for rain and strong winds.
13. When leaving the courts, lock the court gate with the padlock, and return smaller items to the clubhouse. Lock the clubhouse by pressing the centre lock button. **CHECK THAT THE LOCK ENGAGED.** Little trick: Sometimes the lock will not engage. In this case, open the door, press the bolt on the latch and try again.
14. If there are any unresolved issues on the courts (e.g., player conduct, facilities or equipment) please contact the club through the email grandbendpickleballclub@gmail.com.
15. All garbage and recycling are the responsibility of individual club members. Whatever members bring to the courts, leaves with them.
16. Members under 16 years of age must be accompanied by a supervising adult i.e., parent, guardian or authorized/certified coach. All supervisors must be club members.
17. Do not share the code provided by the club. If the code needs to be changed, you will be notified through the email. Only members who have signed this waiver may open the courts.
18. The guest policy applies only to Open Social Play time slots May 1 to Oct 31. The Court Convener will ensure a waiver is signed and the guest's PCO membership is verified. There is a binder in the club house with the waivers. The fee is \$5.
19. If a major injury occurs, call 9-1-1. There is an incident report that must be completed within 7 (seven) days. A copy of the completed incident form will be automatically sent to the club email when our email is used in the electronic form. If you need assistance with the form, please contact grandbendpickleballclub@gmail.com. All injury related forms can be found on our website under INJURY FORMS.

I understand I am responsible for checking shoe tags and ensuring that ONLY club members or insured persons are inside the fenced courts at TRIDON. Members that knowingly permit unauthorized persons on the courts, will be subject to discipline up to and including the removal of their membership.
