Sport Manitoba has approved your association's application for recognition. Pickleball Manitoba will be recognized as a Provincial Sport Organization (PSO), effective May 1, 2026.

All recognized PSOs must continue to meet all Sport Manitoba's recognition criteria and annual "Terms & Conditions for Funding" on an ongoing basis. Your association will be monitored to ensure all funding, reporting, inclusionary and policy requirements continue to be met.


Effective May 1, 2026, PickleBall Manitoba will be eligible for services such as meeting rooms, insurance, mail and print services on a fee-for-service basis. In addition, your association will be eligible to apply for program-specific grants such as community development, MBL, coaching and officials development grants and programs.

Your association will be eligible for base funding for the next four-year PSO Base Funding Cycle (April 1, 2027, to March 31, 2031). A further communication will follow next week outlining base funding levels.

John Blacher, Director of Sport, will contact you to set up a meeting to further discuss the above requirements and your association's eligibility for funding and services.
