Notes: A College Neet and a High School Meet involving athletes from many parts of Canada were held in conjunction with the Championships... No half fares were available from the Canadian Government - consequently the standard of competition was lower than would normally be expected at a Canadian Championship although the presence of US athletes such as Charlie Greene, Vicki Foltz and 17 year old Pat VanWolverlaere certainly raised the standards... the Alberta Track and Field Association made an excellent job of the Meet, and distributed tabulated results to the press and to Clubs ... Willie Turner equalled the world record and Marry Jerome equalled the Canadian record in the 50 Yards held at Calgary the following week, by running 5.1 and 5.2 respectively ... Bill McDonald; who equalled the Canadian record in the 440 Yards with 50.5, and who looked so impressive in winning the Junior Tri-Country 440, ran a 1.55.5 880 Yards in the College Meet, finishing third behind Ray Haswell and Dave Ellis ... some of the better performances in the College Meet were in the jumping events, where Wilf Wedman leapt 6'9% in the High Jump and Gordon Dong, better known as a hurdler, long jumped 22'4.
